Beginning Black and White Photography: This introductory camp will teach you to be comfortable and familiar with the manual operation and basic workings of the 35mm camera. You will learn photographic composition, exposure techniques, and how to deal with natural and artificial lighting. We will develop black and white film and make black and white enlargements. Emphasis will be placed on creativity and learning how to incorporate compositional elements that will allow a beginner to turn ordinary photos into great photos. You must have a 35mm camera with manual control settings. •\$250 includes basic materials

Intensive Black and White Darkroom: If you take photography in school, have completed the *Beginning B/W Photography Workshop*, or do photography as a hobby, you are ready for the next step. We will concentrate on intensive instruction in black-and-white enlargements and film processing options to help you create beautiful images. •\$250 includes basic materials.

In addition, his teaching experience includes workshops for the Austin Museum of Art School of Art, Artist-Mentor at St. Andrew's Episcopal School and faculty member at St. Edwards University and Austin Community College. Mr. Ehrlich owned Custom Photographic Labs in Austin for many years.
